The criteria incorporate the expertise of a multidisciplinary panel of mental health specialists that includes more than 145 psychiatrists, psychologists, neurologists, pharmacists, applied behavioral analysts and other related specialists.

Q&A Format—This easy-to-use format is organized by service and relevant age populations. Care managers can quickly evaluate the severity of symptoms, consider conservative treatment options, and rule out any contraindications. The algorithm accommodates clinical presentation complexity and numerous service indications to derive a patient-specific recommendation.

Quantitative

Recommendations—In relevant cases, the solution provides objective, evidence-based recommendations around service units (e.g., hours of testing, visits).

Care Setting Guidance—Within a single workflow, the solution recommends whether a surgery or invasive procedure should be performed on an inpatient or outpatient basis based upon medical evidence and the patient's condition.

Aggregated Services Coverage—Interventions across the InterQual portfolio that are relevant to behavioral health patients are consolidated.
